GAME STANDARDS

1. There is score kept and games are to be officiated by a Coach, Asst Coach or Team Parent with valid administrator credentials (Admin ID Card), only one official on the field
2. Gear:
 - a. Ball size 3
 - b. Soccer cleats, no metal cleats, no football cleats
 - c. Shin guards
3. Number of players on the field, 9v9

<u>Minimum</u>	<u>Max</u>
6	9
4. Duration of game: Four 8 minutes quarters with 2 minutes breaks between the 1st and 2nd and the 3rd and 4th quarter, with one 5 minutes break between halves.
5. 2 Player advantage rule is in effect. For reasons of fairness, no teams shall play a game with more than a 2 players advantage on the field.
6. Free substitution shall be allowed with the consent of the referee at any stoppage of play.
7. Each player must play a minimum of 50% of the total playing time of the game, provided the player has attended at least to 1 of the practices preceding that game.
8. Offsides: No offsides
9. Fouls & Misconduct:
 - a. All fouls will result in an INDIRECT FREE KICK with the opponents five yards away. The game official shall explain all infractions to the offending team/Coach.
10. Free Kicks:
 - a. All kicks shall be classified under on heading, INDIRECT.
 - b. Opponents must be 3 yards away from the ball.
11. Penalty Kicks: Opponents must be 3 yards away from the ball.
12. Throw-Ins: There are throw-ins.
13. Goal Kicks: Opponents must be 3 yards away from the ball.
14. Corner Kicks: Opponents must be 3 yards away from the ball.
15. League standings will be recorded as follows;
Point value for league games:
Win... 3 points
Tie... 1 point
Loss... 0 points
Points shall be deducted for team's misconduct, pursuant to PYSL Rules of Competition
In the even of a tie between teams the following formula will be used in determining the tiebreaker;
 - a. Head to head
 - b. Number of shutouts wins excluding forfeits
 - c. Goals
 - d. Sportsmanship Points
 - e. Play-off game to determine 1st, 2nd or 3rd place (only)
